Why cite and reference

Definitions and Why

Citation: Its is a quotation from or reference to a book, journal article in a scholarly work etc.

It is a way of informing your readers that certain passage or information from your work is from another source.

Referencing: Referencing is acknowledging the sources of information used in your scholarly work.

It links citation in the main text to the reference list. Reference list contains all sources consulted and cited in your work.

Basics on preparing APA Reference List

- a) The reference should be on a new page at the end of the document
- b) The title (Reference) should be centered.
- c) Should be alphabetically by name of first author (or title if the author isn't known, in this case a, an and the should be ignored)
- d) Contain full references for all citations used in the document.
